

What Murphy's Law LLC Does	Where You May Be Referred to Another Attorney or Firm
Construct a Prenuptial Agreement so you can get married with confidence	File/Respond to divorce or legal separation--exceptions for clients for whom I drafted a prenup
Help the parties create and draft an agreed dissolution of marriage or parenting time/child support agreement and order (represent <i>neither</i> party)	File/Respond to child support or parenting time petition of adverse party, or file petitions/seeking emergency orders in a DM case
Help businesses to create and update employee policies and manuals	File an employment action against your employer, whether administrative or civil
Advise businesses on potential employment law issues and best practices to prevent harm	Defend against a lawsuit filed on behalf of employees or vendors
Help to construct, wind down, or dissolve corporations, LLC's, or other business entities	File or defend suit against former business partners or entities
Construct transfer agreements or related documents for real or personal property, help parties with purchase/sale or transfer of deed	Sue a neighbor or seller for violations of property boundaries or handle contract disputes through litigation
Write a lease or purchase-option lease to protect parties who want to make a property agreement	Handle evictions or landlord/tenant disputes
Plan farm or business succession	Intervene when a client is unhappy with another's succession plan
Estate planning and power of attorney construction, probate of client estates	Probate of estates constructed by another attorney, or challenge wills or codicils on behalf of a party
Help a domestic violence or stalking victim to obtain and maintain protective orders	Defend against a protective order filed by someone else (exceptions for existing clients)
